

# **Application for Hugh O'Brian Leadership Competition**

Each year, SBA selects one **sophomore** ambassador to attend the Hugh O'Brian Leadership Seminar, a three-day experience that will be held this year at Albright College, June 8-June 10. Registration costs are paid by Saint Basil Academy.

To qualify for this opportunity, you will need to write an essay on the following topic, and *turn it in to Mrs. Corrick in the Counseling Services Department by Monday, November 27. No late entries will be accepted.*

**TOPIC: In one to two pages, please describe how and why you want to be a leader in your school and community. Please see the rubric on the back. In your essay, address the following:**

**Why are you interested in representing SBA at the Hugh O'Brian Leadership Seminar?**

**How are you sensitive and concerned about others and issues in your community?**

**What is both rewarding and challenging about being a good leader?**

**What skills do you possess that will contribute to your being a good leader? (i.e. courage to speak out and challenge status quo, critical thinking, creative problem-solving, strong communication skills)**

Only typed essays will be read. Please include your name on your essay. A selection committee will choose one ambassador based on the essay and demonstrated character of each applicant.

Please rate the following qualities of the essay on a scale of 1 to 5, with 5 being the highest:
