The due date is November 27 and is to be submitted to Mrs. Corrick in the Counseling Services Department. A selection committee will choose one student ambassador to represent our school based on her 1) ability to communicate, think critically and problem solve; 2) sensitivity and desire to help others; and 3) courage and strength to speak out and challenge problems that exist in her community.
